Ordinance No. 88-1Passed January 4, 19 88

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD PICKAWAY COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT WE ESTABLISH A SICK PAY, VACATION PAY, AND HOLIDAY SCHEDULE FOR THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD:

SECTION 1: All regular (part time) and (full time) employees, except auxiliaries, will receive two weeks paid vacation after their first full year of employment and every year up to and through the seventh year of employment. Employees with over eight years of service will receive three weeks paid vacation. Vacation time must be used and cannot be accumulated.

SECTION 2: All regular (part time and full time) employees, except auxiliaries will accrue 4.6 hours of sick leave for each eighty hours of service.

SECTION 3: Unused sick leave shall be cumulative without limit. When sick leave is used, it shall be deducted from the employee's credit on the basis of one hour for every hour of absence from previously scheduled work.

SECTION 4: The previously accumulated sick leave of an employee who has been separated from the public service, shall be placed to his credit upon his re-employment in the public service, provided that such re-employment takes place within ten years of the date on which the employee was last terminated from public service.

SECTION 5: Upon retirement or resignation from public service only, an employee may receive compensation based on 1/4 (one fourth) of the total sick leave balance based on his/her hourly wage rate at the time of leaving public service. Compensation for sick leave may not exceed one month's total salary.

SECTION 6: The following days are declared as legal holidays for all regular employees, except auxiliaries: Memorial Day, 4th of July, President's Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas, Labor Day, New Years, Martin Luther King Day, Columbus Day, and Veterans Day.

SECTION 7: This resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law and will repeal any and all other ordinances or resolutions concerning vacation, sick pay, and holiday.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD, PICKAWAY COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: The Village is authorized by statute to employ legal counsel as its Village Solicitor.

SECTION 2: James K. Hill, Attorney-at-law, 209 East Main Street, Circleville, Ohio 43113, has agreed to serve as Village Solicitor commencing January 1, 1988 and ending December 31, 1988.

SECTION 3: The Mayor and the Clerk be, and they hereby are, authorized to enter a contract for James K. Hill, Attorney-at-law to serve the Village as Solicitor at the rate of \$50.00 per hour, excluding time for travel to and from Council meetings.

SECTION 4: The services of solicitor will include representing the Village in or out of court, relative to transactions, affairs and functions of the Village, except the prosecution of criminal or traffic cases before the Mayor's Court or Municipal Court. The Village will also reimburse the solicitor for filing and or recording fees.

An ORDINANCE to make appropriations for Current Expenses and other Expenditures of the Village of South Bloomfield, State of Ohio, during the fiscal year ending December 31, 1988.

Section 1. BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of South Bloomfield, State of Ohio, that, to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the said Village of South Bloomfield during the fiscal year ending December 31, 1988, the following sums be and they are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows, viz:

Section 2. That there be appropriated from the GENERAL FUND:

And the Village Clerk is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the Village Treasurer for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefor, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. Provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village, and for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.

SECTION 12. This resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.

DATE OF ENACTMENT 9-6-88

An emergency ordinance enacted by the Village of South Bloomfield,
Pickaway County, Ohio, in the matter of the hereinafter described
improvement, and to request cooperation from the Director of Transportation.

WHEREAS, the Village has identified the need for and proposes the improvement of a portion of the public highway which is described as follows: By planing the existing surface, by repairing the existing pavement, and by resurfacing with asphaltic concrete, beginning at the South Bloomfield south corporation (S.L.M. 16.62) and ending at the South Bloomfield north corporation (S.L.M. 17.59).

said portion of highway within the municipal corporation limits being hereinafter referred to as the improvement, and

WHEREAS, the Village further desires cooperation from the Director of Transportation in the planning, design and construction of said improvement.

NOW THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of South Bloomfield, Ohio:

SECTION I (Cooperation)

That said Village hereby requests the cooperation of the Director of Transportation, in the cost of the above described improvement as follows:

SECTION I - A

That the Consent Only

is hereby appropriated for the improvement of the highway as described hereinabove, by the Village.

SECTION II (Consent)

That it is declared to be in the public interest that the consent of said Village be and such consent is hereby given to the Director of Transportation to construct the above described improvement, in accordance with plans, specifications and estimates as approved by the Director.

SECTION III (Authority to Sign)

That the Mayor of said Village, is hereby authorized
(Contractual Officer's Title)

to enter into maintenance and parking agreements and special contractual obligations.

SECTION IV (Maintenance, Parking Traffic Control Signals and Devices)

That upon completion of said improvement, said Village, will thereafter keep said highway open to traffic at all times, and

- (a) Maintain the improvement in accordance with the provisions of the statutes relating thereto and make ample financial and other provisions for such maintenance; and
- (b) Maintain the right-of-way and keep it free of obstructions in a manner satisfactory to the State of Ohio and hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes and permit no signs, posters, billboards, roadside stands or other private installations within the right-of-way limits; and
- (c) Place and maintain all traffic control devices conforming to the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices on the improvement in compliance with the provisions of Section 4511.11 and related sections of the Ohio Revised Code; and
- (d) Regulate parking in the following manner:

Prohibit parking within the limits of the improvement.

SECTION V

(Right-of-Way, Utility Rearrangement and Damage and Liability Responsibilities)

- (a) That all existing street and public way right-of-way within the Village which is necessary for the aforesaid improvement, shall be made available therefor.
- (b) That the ~~State~~ Village will acquire any additional right-of-way required for the construction of the aforesaid improvement.
- (c) That arrangements have been or will be made with and agreements obtained from all public utility companies whose lines or structures will be affected by the said improvement and said companies have agreed to make any and all necessary plant removals or rearrangements in such manner as to be clear of any construction called for by the plans of said improvement and said companies have agreed to make such necessary rearrangements immediately after notification by said Village or the Department of Transportation.
- (d) That it is hereby agreed that the Village shall at its own expense, make all rearrangements of water mains, service lines, fire hydrants, valve boxes, sanitary sewers or other municipally owned utilities and/or any appurtenances thereto, which do not comply with the provisions of Directive No. DH-P-411.
- (e) That the construction, reconstruction, and/or rearrangement of both publicly and privately owned utilities, referred to in subsections (c) and (d) above, shall be done in such a manner as not to interfere unduly with the operation of the contractor constructing the improvement and all backfilling of trenches made necessary by such utility rearrangements shall be performed in accordance with the provisions of the Ohio Department of Transportation Construction and Material Specifications and shall be subject to approval by the State.
- (f) That the installation of all utility facilities on the right-of-way shall conform with the requirements of the Federal Highway Administration Policy and Procedure Memorandum 30-4 "Utility Relocations and Adjustments" and the Department of Transportation's rules on Utility Accommodation.
- (g) That the Village hereby agrees to accept responsibility for any and all damages or claims for which it is legally liable arising from the negligence of its officers, employees or agents in the performance of the Village's obligations made or agreed to in Sections (a), (b), (c), (d), (e) and (f) hereinabove. Likewise, The State agrees to accept responsibility for any and all damages or claims for which it is legally liable arising from the negligence of its officers, employees or agents in the performance of the State's obligations made or agreed to in Sections (a), (b), (c), (d), (e) and (f) hereinabove.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure by reason of the need for expediting highway improvements to promote highway safety, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
