THE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING, DECEMBER 31, 1998.

SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD, TO PROVIDE FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF SAID VILLAGE DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1998. THE FOLLOWING SUMS BE AND THEY ARE HEREBY SET ASIDE AND APPROPRIATED AS FOLLOWS;

THE CLERK-TREASURER IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO DRAW WARRANTS ON THE VILLAGE TREASURER FOR PAYMENTS FROM ANY OF THE FOREGOING APPROPRIATIONS UPON RECEIVING CERTIFICATES AND VOUCHERS THEREFORE, APPROVED BY THE BOARD OR OFFICERS AUTHORIZED BY LAW TO APPROVE AND SAME, OR AN ORDINANCE OR NO WARRANTS SHALL BE DRAWN OR PAID FOR SALARIES, OR WAGES EXCEPT TO PERSONS EMPLOYED BY THE AUTHORITY OF AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH LAW OR ORDINANCE. PROVIDED FURTHER THAT THE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CONTINGENCIES CAN ONLY BE EXPENDED UPON APPEAL OF TWO-THIRDS VOTE OF COUNCIL FOR ITEMS OF EXPENSE CONSTITUTING A LEGAL OBLIGATION AGAINST THE VILLAGE, AND FOR THE PURPOSES OTHER THAN THOSE COVERED BY OTHER SPECIFIC APPROPRIATIONS HEREIN MADE.

SECTION 3. THIS ORDINANCE IS HEREBY DECLARED TO BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE, AND IT WILL TAKE EFFECT AT ONCE.

ORDINANCE NO. 98-03

CROSS CONNECTION CONTROL ORDINANCE

TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE MEANS FOR PROTECTING THE PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM FROM CONTAMINATION DUE TO BACKFLOW OF CONTAMINANTS THROUGH THE WATER SERVICE CONNECTION INTO THE PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, SECTION 6109.13 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE REQUIRES PROTECTION OF THE PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM FROM CONTAMINATION THROUGH ANY CONNECTION WHEREBY WATER FROM A PRIVATE, AUXILIARY OR EMERGENCY WATER SYSTEM MAY ENTER THE PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM AND

WHEREAS, SECTION 3745-95 OF THE OHIO ADMINISTRATIVE CODE REQUIRES PROTECTION OF THE PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM FROM CONTAMINATION DUE TO BACKFLOW OF CONTAMINANTS THROUGH THE WATER SERVICE CONNECTION; AND

WHEREAS, THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY REQUIRES THE MAINTANCE OF A CONTINUING PROGRAM OF CROSS-CONNECTION CONTROL WHICH WILL SYSTEMATICALLY AND EFFECTIVELY PREVENT THE CONTAMINATION OF ALL POTABLE WATER SYSTEMS; AND

WHEREAS, IN ORDER TO ACOMPLISH THESE GOALS IT IS NECESSARY TO INTRODUCE RESTRICTIONS THAT GO BEYOND USUAL PLUMBING CODE REQUIREMENTS, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD, PICKAWAY COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

SECTION 1. THAT IF, IN THE JUDGEMENT OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS, AN APPROVED BACKFLOW PREVENTION DEVICE IS NECESSARY FOR THE SAFETY OF THE PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM, THE BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS WILL GIVE NOTICE TO THE WATER CONSUMER TO INSTALL SUCH AN APPROVED DEVICE IMMEDIATELY. THE WATER CONSUMER SHALL AT HIS OWN EXPENSE, INSTALL SUCH AN APPROVED DEVICE AT A LOCATION AND IN A MANNER APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS AND SHALL HAVE INSPECTIONS AND TESTS MADE OF SUCH APPROVED DEVICES AS REQUIRED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS

SECTION 2. THAT NO PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION SHALL ESTABLISH OR PERMIT TO BE ESTABLISHED OR MAINTAIN OR PERMIT TO BE MAINTAINED ANY CONNECTION WHEREBY A PRIVATE, AUXILIARY OR EMERGENCY WATER SUPPLY OTHER THAN THE REGULAR PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY OF VILLAGE OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD MAY ENTER THE SUPPLY OR DISTRIBUTING SYSTEM OF SAID MUNICIPALITY, UNLESS SUCH PRIVATE AUXILIARY OR EMERGENCY WATER SUPPLY AND THE METHOD OF CONNECTION AND USE OF SUCH SUPPLY SHALL HAVD BEEN APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS AND THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY.

SECTION 3. NO WATER SERVICE CONNECTION SHALL BE INSTALLED OR MAINTAINED TO ANY PREMISES WHERE ACTUAL OR POTENTIAL CROSS-CONNECTIONS TO THE PUBLIC POTABLE OR CONSUMER'S WATER SYSTEM MAY EXIST UNLESS SUCH ACTUAL OR POTENTIAL CROSS-CONNECTIONS ARE ABATED OR CONTROLLED TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS.

SECTION 4. NO CONNECTION SHALL BE INSTALLED OR MAINTAINED WHEREBY WATER FROM AN AUXILIARY WATER SYSTEM MAY ENTER A PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM AND THE METHOD OF CONNECTION AND USE OF SUCH SYSTEM SHALL HAVE BEEN APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS AND THE DIRECTOR OF THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY AS REQUIRED BY SECTION 6109.13 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE.

SECTION 5. THAT IT SHALL BE THE DUTY OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS TO CAUSE SURVEYS AND INVESTIGATIONS TO BE MADE OF INDUSTRIAL AND OTHER PROPERTIES SERVED BY THE PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY WHERE ACTUAL OR POTENTIAL HAZARDS TO THE PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY MAY EXIST.

SECTION 6. THAT THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD OR ONE OF ITS DULY AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE SHALL HAVE THE RIGHT TO ENTER AT ANY REASONABLE TIME ANY PROPERTY SERVED BY A CONNECTION TO THE PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY OR DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD FOR THE PURPOSE OF INSPECTING THE PIPING SYSTEM OR SYSTEMS THEREOF.

SECTION 7. THAT THE BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS ARE HEREBY AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO DISCONTINUE, AFTER REASONABLE NOTICE TO THE OCCUPANT THEREOF, THE WATER SERVICE TO ANY PROPERTY TO ANY PROPERTY WHEREIN ANY CONNECTION IN VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE IS KNOWN TO EXIST, AND TO TAKE SUCH OTHER PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES AS HE MAY DEEM NECESSARY TO ELIMINATE ANY DANGER OF CONTAMINATION OF THE PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY DISTRIBUTION MAINS. WATER SERVICE TO SUCH PROPERTY SHALL NOT BE RESTORED UNTIL SUCH CONDITIONS SHALL HAVE BEEN ELIMINATED OR CORRECTED IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

SECTION 8. A RE-CONNECTION CHARGE OF \$ 50.00 SHALL BE CHARGED PER EACH DIS-CONNECTION AND RE-CONNECTION TO HAVE PROPERTY IN COMPLIANCE WITH THIS ORDINANCE.

SECTION 9. THAT WHOEVER VIOLATES THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE GUILTY OF A MINOR MISDEMEANOR AND FINED UP TO A MAXIMUM OF \$100.00 PER DAY OF VIOLATION .

SECTION 10. THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FULL FORCE FROM AND AFTER THE EARLIEST PERIOD ALLOWED BY LAW.

AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SOUTH BLOOMFIELD
COOPERATIVE PURCHASING

WHEREAS, OHIO'S COOPERATIVE PURCHASING ACT (Am. Sub. H.B. No. 100) was signed into law on December 4, 1985; and

WHEREAS, effective March 6, 1986, Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Act provides the opportunity for counties, townships, municipal corporations, regional transit authorities, regional airport authorities or port authorities and school districts, conservancy districts, township park districts and park districts, to participate in contracts issued by the state of OHIO, Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment and certain materials, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD, PICKAWAY COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT;

Section 1. That the Mayor, hereby requests authority in the name of the Village of South Bloomfield to participate in state contracts which the Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing has entered into for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment and certain materials pursuant to Revised Code Section 125.04.

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to agree in the name of the Village of South Bloomfield to be bound by all contract terms and conditions as the Department of Administrative Services, Office of the State Purchasing prescribes. Such terms and conditions may include a reasonable fee to cover the administrative costs which the Department of Administrative Services incurs as a result of Village of South Bloomfield participation in a contract. Further, that the Mayor does hereby agree to be bound by all such terms and conditions.

Section 3. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to agree in the name of the Village of South Bloomfield to directly pay the vendor, under each such state contract in which it participates for items it receives pursuant to the contract, and the Mayor does hereby agree to directly pay the vendor.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure to ensure the bid price for a tractor.

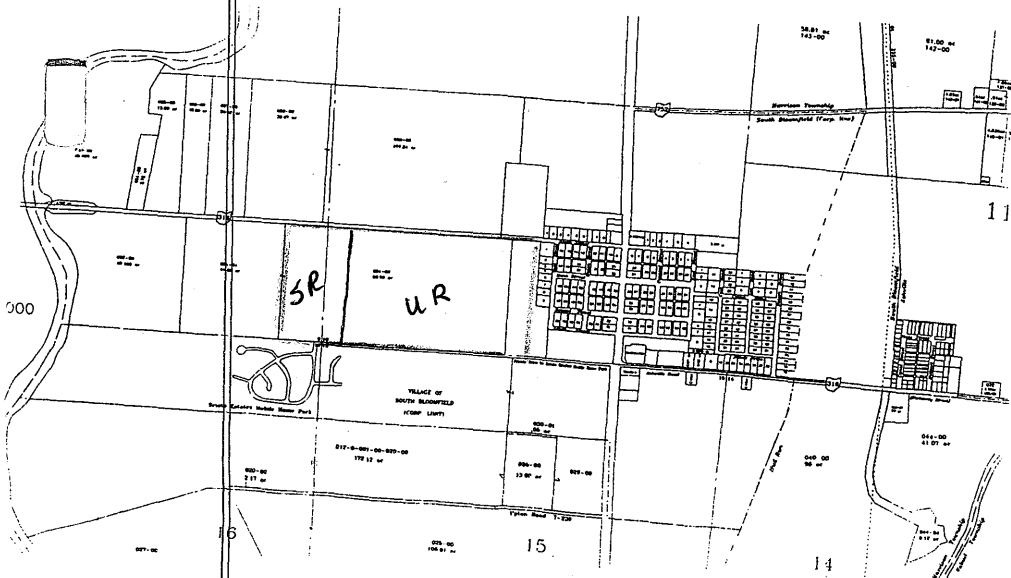

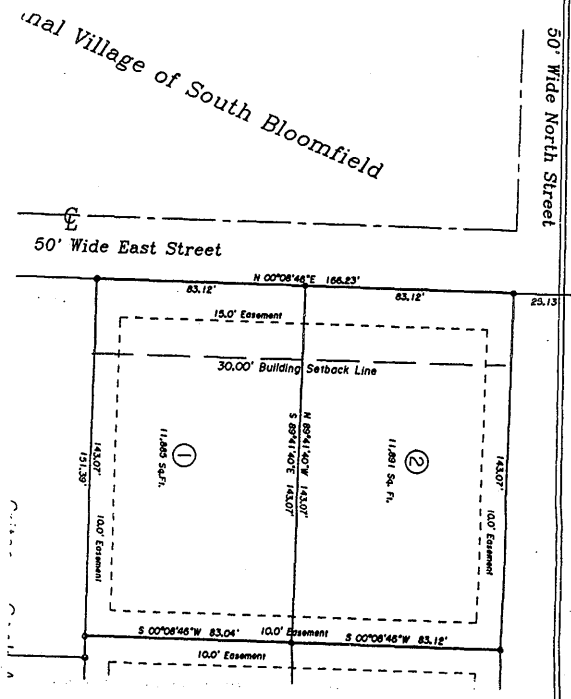

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE FINAL DRAFT AMENDED SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN OF THE ROSS, PICKAWAY, HIGHLAND, FAYETTE JOINT SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS (BOARD) OF THE ROSS, PICKAWAY, HIGHLAND, FAYETTE JOINT SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT (DISTRICT) HAS ESTABLISHED AND CONVENED A "SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT POLICY COMMITTEE" IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 3734.54 OF THE REVISED CODE (POLICY COMMITTEE) TO PREPARE, ADOPT AND SUBMIT TO THE DIRECTOR OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL, A "SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN" FOR THE DISTRICT AS REQUIRED BY SECTION 3734.54 (PLAN); AND

WHEREAS, THE DISTRICT IS CURRENTLY IMPLEMENTING SUCH AN APPROVED SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN, AND

WHEREAS, THE DISTRICT IS REQUIRED BY SECTION 3734.56 OF THE REVISED CODE TO AMEND THE APPROVED PLAN ON A TRIENNIAL BASIS; AND

WHEREAS, THE POLICY COMMITTEE COMPLETED A DRAFT AMENDED PLAN FOR THE DISTRICT AND SUBMITTED THAT AMENDED PLAN TO THE DIRECTOR OF THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR PRELIMINARY REVIEW AND COMMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTIONS 3734.54 AND 3734.55 OF THE REVISED CODE, AND

WHEREAS, THE POLICY COMMITTEE RECEIVED THE DIRECTOR'S WRITTEN, NONBINDING ADVISORY OPIONION REGARDING THE DRAFT AMENDED PLAN AND ESTABLISHED A PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD AND HELD A PUBLIC HEARING ON SEPTEMBER 22, 1998 CONCERNING THE DRAFT AMENDED PLAN, AND
