ORDINANCE 2012-05

AN ORDINANCE TO ADJUST SEWER RATES AND TO REPEAL AND REPLACE ORDINANCES 2001-09 AND ORDINANCE 2009-08

WHEREAS: IT HAS BECOME NECESSARY TO ADJUST THE WASTE WATER RATES OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED THAT THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD, PICKAWAY COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO THAT,

SECTION ONE: ORDINANCE 2001-09

ORDINANCE TO SET SEWER RATES WHEREAS, THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS HAS REVIEWED THE FINANCES FOR THE SEWER DEPT. THEY ARE RECOMMENDING THE FOLLOWING SEWER RATE ORDINANCE BE ADOPTED.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD, PICKAWAY COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT;

SECTION 1. THE SEWER RATE WILL BE A SET FEE OF \$25.00 FOR WATER USAGE FROM 0 GALLONS TO 1,000 GALLONS. FROM 1001 GALLONS ON IT WILL BE \$ 6.00 PER THOUSAND.

SECTION 2. ALL PROPERTY OWNERS WHO ARE NOT CONNECTED TO THE VILLAGE WATER SYSTEM, BUT ARE CONNECTED TO THE VILLAGE SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM WILL PAY A FLAT FEE OF \$ 40.00 PER MONTH FOR SANITARY SEWER.

SECTION 3. SAID WATER/SEWER AND TRASH BILLS WILL CONTINUE T BE BILLED MONTHLY WITH THE DUE DATE ON THE 21ST OF EACH MON FOLLOWING BILLING.

SECTION 4. ALL PROPERTY OWNERS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL WATER/SEWER AND TRASH BILLS WHETHER OWNERS OR RENTALS.

SECTION 5. A SET RATE OF 10% LATE FEE WILL BE ADDED TO ALL BALANCES DUE EACH MONTH, AFTER THE DUE DATE HAS PASSED.

SECTION 6. THIS ORDINANCE SHALL REPEAL ANY AND ALL PREVIOUS PASSED ORDINANCES CONCERNING THE FEES FOR SANITARY SEWER USEAGE.

SECTION 7. THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FULL FORGE FROM AND AFTER THE EARLIEST PERIOD ALLOWED BY LAW.

PASSED ON MARCH 20, 2001, IS HEREBY REPEALED IN ITS ENTIRITY.

SECTION TWO: ORDINANCE 2009-08,

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SEWER RATES OF ORDINANCE 2001-09 WHEREAS IT HAS BECOME NECESSARY TO AMEND SEWER RATES OF ORDINANCE 2001-09

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED THAT THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD, PICKAWAY COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO THAT,

SECTION ONE: THE SEWER BASE RATE WILL BE BASED UPON THE NATIONAL ESTIMATED DAILY USAGE GUIDE WITH 5/8 INCH WATERLINE BASE BEING \$25.00 INCLUDING THE FIRST 1000 GALLONS. ANYTHING ABOVE 5/8 INCH IS EDU GUIDELINES (ATTACHMENT A).

SECTION TWO: THE SEWER USAGE CHARGE WILL BE A BLOCK BILLING RATE, THE CHARGE PER THOUSAND GALLONS OF WATER USED WILL BE CHARGED AS FOLLOWS:

1,000 – 8,000 GALLONS PER MONTH	\$6.50 PER THOUSAND
8,001 - 10,000 GALLONS PER MONTH	\$7.00 PER THOUSAND
10,001 – 15,000 GALLONS PER MONTH	\$7.50 PER THOUSAND
15,001 – 30,000 GALLONS PER MONTH	\$8.00 PER THOUSAND
30,001 – UP GALLONS PER MONTH	\$8.50 PER THOUSAND

SECTION THREE: SECTION ONE OF ORDINANCE 2001-09, THE SEWER RATE WILL BE A SET FEE OF \$25.00 FOR WATER USAGE FROM 0 GALLONS TO 1,000 GALLONS, FROM 1,001 GALLONS ON IT WILL BE \$6.00 PER THOUSAND, IS REPEALED IN IT ENTIRITY.

SECTION FOUR: THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FULL FORGE FROM AND AFTER THE EARLIEST PERIOD ALLOWED BY LAW,

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PASSED JANUARY 19, 2010, IS HEREBY REPEALED IN ITS ENTIRITY

SECTION THREE: THE SEWER BASE RATE WILL BE BASED UPON THE NATIONAL ESTIMATED DAILY USAGE GUIDE WITH 5/8 INCH WATERLINE BASE BEING \$36.00. ANYTHING ABOVE 5/8 INCH IS EDU GUIDELINES (ATTACHMENT A).

SECTION FOUR: THE SEWER USAGE CHARGE WILL BE A BLOCK BILLING RATE, THE CHARGE PER THOUSAND GALLONS OF WATER USED WILL BE CHARGED AS FOLLOWS:

0 - 8,000 GALLONS PER MONTH	\$7.50 PER THOUSAND
8,001 - 10,000 GALLONS PER MONTH	\$8.00 PER THOUSAND
10,001 - 15,000 GALLONS PER MONTH	\$8.50 PER THOUSAND
15,001 - 30,000 GALLONS PER MONTH	\$9.00 PER THOUSAND
30,001 - UP GALLONS PER MONTH	\$9.50 PER THOUSAND

SECTION FIVE: ALL PROPERTY OWNERS WHO ARE CONNECTED TO THE VILLAGE WASTEWATER SYSTEM AND NOT HAVING A METERING DEVICE CONNECTED SHALL PAY A FLAT FEE OF \$60.00 PER MONTH FOR WASTEWATER SERVICE.

SECTION SIX: THE PROPERTY OWNER WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYMENT OF WASTEWATER, WATER AND TRASH BILLS ACCUMULATED FOR SAID SERVICE.

SECTION SEVEN: SAID FEES FOR WATER, WASTEWATER AND TRASH WILL BE CALCULATED AND BILLED MONTHLY. DUE DATE FOR SAID FEES SHALL BE THE 15th OF EACH MONTH.

SECTION EIGHT: A SET FEE OF 10% WILL BE CHARGED FOR BALANCE DUE AFTER DUE DATE.

SECTION NINE: THE ORDINANCE SHALL REPEAL ANY AND ALL PREVIOUS ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO WASTERWATER RATES AND/OR FEES.

SECTION TEN: THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FULL FORCE FROM AND AFTER THE EARLIEST PERIOD ALLOWED BY LAW.

ORDINANCE NO. 2012-06

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, ADOPTING AND ENACTING AMERICAN LEGAL PUBLISHING'S OHIO BASIC CODE, 2012 EDITION, AS THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the present general and permanent ordinances of the municipality are inadequately arranged and classified and are insufficient in form and substance for the complete preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the municipality and for the proper conduct of its affairs.

WHEREAS, American legal publishing corporation publishes a Code of Ordinances suitable for adoption by municipalities in Ohio.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide for the usual daily operation of the municipality and for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the municipality that this ordinance take effect at an early date.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD, PICKAWAY COUNTY, OHIO.

Section 1. American Legal Publishing's Ohio Basic Code, 2012 Edition, as reviewed and approved by the Legislative Authority, is hereby adopted and enacted. Any prior version of the Ohio Basic Code which may have been previously adopted by the municipality is hereby repealed as obsolete and is hereby replaced in its entirety by this Ohio Basic Code, 2012 Edition.

Section 2. One copy of American Legal Publishing's Ohio Basic Code, 2012 edition, certified as correct by the Mayor and Clerk of the Legislative Authority, as required by Ohio Revised Code 731.23; shall be kept in its initial form on file in the office of the Clerk of the municipality and retained as a permanent ordinance record of the municipality. The Clerk of the municipality is authorized and directed to publish a summary of all new matters contained in the Code of Ordinances as required by Ohio Revised code 731.23. Such summary is attached hereto and marked as "Exhibit A."

Section 3. All ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of the Ohio Basic Code, 2012 Edition, as adopted in Section 1 hereof, are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this ordinance, except as follows:

- (A) The enactment of the Ohio basic Code, 2012 Edition, shall not be construed to affect a right or liability accrued or incurred under any legislative provision prior to the effective date of such enactment, or an action or proceeding for the enforcement of such right or liability. Such enactment shall not be construed to relieve any person from punishment for an act committed in violation of any such legislative provision, or to affect an indictment or prosecution therefore. For such purposes, any such legislative provision shall continue in full force notwithstanding its repeal for purpose of revision and codification.
- (B) The repeal provided above shall not affect:
 - (1) The grant or creation of a franchise, license, right, easement or privilege;
 - (2) The purchase, sale, lease or transfer of property;

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- (3) The appropriation or expenditure of money or promise or guarantee of payment;
- (4) The assumption of nay contract or obligation;
- (5) The issuance and delivery of any bonds, obligations, or other instruments of indebtedness;
- (6) The levy or imposition of taxes, assessments or charges.
- (7) The establishment, naming, vacating or grade level of any street or public way.
- (8) The dedication of property or plat approval;
- (9) The annexation or detachment of territory;
- (10) Any legislation enacted subsequent to the adoption of the ordinance.
- (11) Any legislation specifically superseding the provision of the Ohio Basic Code.

Section 4. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the people of this municipality, and shall take effect at the earliest date provided by law.

ORDINANCE 2012-10

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE FINAL DRAFT AMENDED SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN OF THE ROSS, PICKAWAY, HIGHLAND, FAYETTE JOINT SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors (Board) of the Ross-Pickaway, Highland, Fayette Joint Solid Waste Management District (District) has established and convened a "solid waste management policy committee" in accordance with Section 3734.54 of the Revised Code (Policy Committee) to prepare, adopt, and submit to the Director of the Environmental Protection Agency for review and approval, a "solid waste management plan" for the District as required by Section 3734.54 (Plan); and

WHEREAS, the District is currently implementing such an approved solid waste management plan; and

WHEREAS, the District is required by Section 3734.56 of the Revised Code to amend the approved Plan every five years; and

WHEREAS, the Policy Committee completed a draft amended Plan for the District and submitted that amended Plan to the Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency for preliminary review and comment in accordance with Sections 3734.54 and 3734.55 of the Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, the Policy Committee received the Director's written, nonbinding advisory opinion regarding the draft amended Plan and established a public comment period and held a public hearing on concerning the draft amended plan; and

WHEREAS, the Policy Committee, after consideration of comments and recommendations received concerning the draft amended Plan, has adopted and submitted to this legislative authority a copy of the draft amended Plan for the District as so adopted (the "Final Draft Amended Plan"); and

WHEREAS, this legislative authority is required by Division (B) of Section 3734.55 of the Revised Code to approve or disapprove the Final Draft Amended Plan within 90 days after receiving -a copy of the Final Draft Amended Plan and has been requested to approve the Final Draft Amended Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of South Bloomfield, County of Pickaway, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Final Draft Amended Plan is hereby approved in the form submitted to this legislative authority and presently on file with the Clerk of this legislative authority.

Section 2. The Clerk of this legislative authority is hereby authorized and directed to mail or otherwise deliver promptly a certified copy of this resolution to the Policy Committee.
