ORDINANCE NO. 2013-02

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, ADOPTING AND ENACTING AMERICAN LEGAL PUBLISHING'S OHIO BASIC CODE, 2013 EDITION, AS THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the present general and permanent ordinances of the municipality are inadequately arranged and classified and are insufficient in form and substance for the complete preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the municipality and for the proper conduct of its affairs.

WHEREAS, American legal publishing corporation publishes a Code of Ordinances suitable for adoption by municipalities in Ohio:

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide for the usual daily operation of the municipality and for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the municipality that this ordinance take effect at an early date.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD, PICKAWAY COUNTY, OHIO.

Section 1. American Legal Publishing's Ohio Basic Code, 2013 Edition, as reviewed and approved by the Legislative Authority, is hereby adopted and enacted. Any prior version of the Ohio Basic Code which may have been previously adopted by the municipality is hereby repealed as obsolete and is hereby replaced in its entirety by this Ohio Basic Code, 2013 Edition.

Section 2. One copy of American Legal Publishing's Ohio Basic Code, 2013 edition, certified as correct by the Mayor and Clerk of the Legislative Authority, as required by Ohio Revised Code 731.23; shall be kept in its initial form on file in the office of the Clerk of the municipality and retained as a permanent ordinance record of the municipality. The Clerk of the municipality is authorized and directed to publish a summary of all new matters contained in the Code of Ordinances as required by Ohio Revised code 731.23. Such summary is attached hereto and marked as "Exhibit A."

Section 3. All ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of the Ohio Basic Code, 2013 Edition, as adopted in Section 1 hereof, are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this ordinance, except as follows:

(A) The enactment of the Ohio basic Code, 2013 Edition, shall not be construed to affect a right or liability accrued or incurred under any legislative provision prior to the effective date of such enactment, or an action or proceeding for the enforcement of such right or liability. Such enactment shall not be construed to relieve any person from punishment for an act committed in violation of any such legislative provision, or to affect an indictment or prosecution therefore. For such purposes, any such legislative provision shall continue in full force notwithstanding its repeal for purpose of revision and codification.

(B) The repeal provided above shall not affect:

- (1) The grant or creation of a franchise, license, right, easement or privilege;
- (2) The purchase, sale, lease or transfer of property;

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- (3) The appropriation or expenditure of money or promise or guarantee of payment;
- (4) The assumption of nay contract or obligation;
- (5) The issuance and delivery of any bonds, obligations, or other instruments of indebtedness;
- (6) The levy or imposition of taxes, assessments or charges.
- (7) The establishment, naming, vacating or grade level of any street or public way.
- (8) The dedication of property or plat approval;
- (9) The annexation or detachment of territory;
- (10) Any legislation enacted subsequent to the adoption of the ordinance.
- (11) Any legislation specifically superseding the provision of the Ohio Basic Code.

Section 4. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the people of this municipality, and shall take effect at the earliest date provided by law.

ORDINANCE 2009-10 SENIOR CITIZEN DISCOUNT

“Eligible Senior citizens” means any customer who

- 1. Is receiving service by means of a single meter to a single family residence
2. I personally responsible for payment of the bill as head of household
3. Is sixty (60) years of age or older having a total income of less than one hundred fifty percent (150%) of the poverty level as published by the U.S. Department of Commerce, Bureau of Census.

“Total income” means adjusted the gross income of the applicant and spouse for the year proceeding on which application for the Senior Citizen adjustment is made, as determined under the “internal Revenue Code of 1954” 26 U.S.C. 1 as amended,

Plus

- Income from the following sources not included in the federal adjusted gross income.
• Old age and survivors benefits received pursuant to the “Social Security Act.”
• Retirements
• Pensions
• Annuities
• Payments received pursuant to the “Railroad Retirement Act.” 45 U.S.C. 231 et seq.,
• Interest on federal, state and local government obligations
• Disability benefits paid by the Veterans Administration or a branch of the armed forces of the United States on account of an injury or disability shall not be included in total income

To be eligible for the Senior Citizen Discount program, applicants must meet the following requirements

- 1. Applicant must be over 60 years of age or older. Application must include document of age.
2. Applicant must have an active Villagé of South Bloomfield water account for their residence in their name (or in their spouses name)
3. Applicant must live in a single family home have one water meter
4. The total household income from the previous year must meet the following income guidelines.

Application must include household size and current documentation of income. All documentation must be dated and include applicant’s name.
