SECTION ONE: COUNCIL AUTHORIZES THE TRANSFER OF \$3,042.24 FROM ACCOUNT 5101-541-000 WATER OPERATING TO ACCOUNT 5721-541-000 WATER DEBT SERVICE ALLOCATING FUNDS FOR PAYMENT OF OPWC LOAN INVOICE AND OWDA LOAN #2879.

SECTION TWO: COUNCIL AUTHORIZES THE TRANSFER OF \$38,646.67 FROM ACCOUNT 5201-541-000 SEWER OPERATING TO FUND 5722-541-000 SEWER DEBT SERVICE ALLOCATING FUNDS FOR PAYMENT OF ODWA LOAN #'S 1891,1892,1893,1894.

A Resolution To Amend Resolution 2012-06,

Regarding OP&F Mandatory Contributions

Whereas, the Ohio Police & Fire Pension mandatory contribution percentages have been changed, and will change again in 2014 and 2015; and, ^{Resolution No.} _____ ^{Passed} _____, 20____

Whereas it is necessary to update and amend Resolution 2012-06, which is included here in its entirety;

The Council of Village of South Bloomfield, Pickaway County, Ohio met at a duly called and authorized meeting of the Council on the date set forth below, such meeting being duly called pursuant to a notice stating the time, place and purpose of the meeting received by all Council members, and the following resolutions were made, seconded, and adopted by those present at the meeting.

WHEREAS, the eligible employees of the Village of South Bloomfield Police Department participate in the Ohio Police & Fire Pension Fund;

WHEREAS, the Village of South Bloomfield Council desire to pick-up all of the ten percent (10%) mandatory contributions required to be paid under Section 742.31 of the Ohio Revised Code for participating employees of Village of South Bloomfield Police Department who are members of the Ohio Police & Fire Pension Fund;

WHEREAS, employers may pay all or a part of the mandatory employee contributions for employees participating in the Ohio Police & Fire Pension Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD THAT;

Section One: The Village of South Bloomfield Council desires to pick-up all of the ten percent (10%) mandatory contributions by the employees who are members of the Ohio Police & Fire Pension Fund by paying the contributions on behalf of the employee effective as of July 5, 2012. No contributions prior to the Council's action shall be picked-up.

Section Two: That said picked up contributions, paid by the employer, even though designated as employee contributions for state law purposes, are being paid by the Village of South Bloomfield Council in lieu of said contributions by the employee;

Section Three: That said picked up contributions will not be included in the gross income of the employees for tax reporting purposes, that is, for federal or state income tax withholding taxes, until distributed from the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund;

Section Four: That said picked up contributions will be included in the gross income of the employees, for employment tax purposes, as the contributions are made to the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund; and

Section Five: That said employees shall not be entitled to any option of choosing to receive the contributed amounts directly instead of having them paid by the Village of South Bloomfield Council to the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund.

Section Six: That this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD, STATE OF OHIO THAT;

1. The third "WHEREAS" clause of Resolution 2012-06 which reads: "WHEREAS, the Village of South Bloomfield Council desire to pick-up all of the ten percent (10%) mandatory contributions required to be paid under Section 742.31 of the Ohio Revised Code for participating employees of Village of South Bloomfield Police Department who are members of the Ohio Police & Fire Pension Fund;" is deleted and of no further effect.

2. The following language is inserted as the new third "WHEREAS" clause of Resolution 2012-06, "WHEREAS, the Village of South Bloomfield Council desire to pick-up all mandatory contributions required to be paid under Section 742.31 of the Ohio Revised Code for participating employees of Village of South Bloomfield Police Department who are members of the Ohio Police & Fire Pension Fund";

3. Section One of Resolution 2012-06 which reads: "Section One: The Village of South Bloomfield Council desires to pick-up all of the ten percent (10%) mandatory contributions by the employees who are members of the Ohio Police & Fire Pension Fund by paying the contributions on behalf of the employee effective as of July 5, 2012. No contributions prior to the Council's action shall be picked-up." is deleted and of no further effect.

4. The following language is inserted as Section One of Resolution 2012-06, "Section One: The Village of South Bloomfield Council desires to pick-up all of the mandatory contributions by the employees who are members of the Ohio Police & Fire Pension Fund by paying the contributions on behalf of the employee effective as of July 5, 2012. No contributions prior to the Council's action shall be picked-up. The following dates and rate changes will apply:

- 7/7/2013 --- 10.75%
- 7/6/2014 --- 11.50%
- 7/5/2015 and thereafter --- 12.25%"

AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION BY THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD TO ADOPT THE PICKAWAY COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, The Village of South Bloomfield, Ohio is most vulnerable to natural hazards which may result in loss of life and property, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000) requires state and local governments to develop and submit for approval to the President a mitigation plan that outlines processes for identifying their respective natural hazards, risks, and vulnerabilities; and

WHEREAS, The Village of South Bloomfield acknowledges the requirements of Section 322 of DMA 2000 to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a prerequisite to receiving post-disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds; and

WHEREAS, The Village of South Bloomfield acknowledges that the Pickaway County 2012 Hazard Mitigation Plan has been developed by the Pickaway County Emergency Management Agency in cooperation with other county departments, and officials and citizens of Pickaway County; and

WHEREAS, The Village of South Bloomfield acknowledges a public involvement process consistent with the requirements of DMA 2000 was conducted to develop the Pickaway County 2012 Hazard Mitigation Plan, and

WHEREAS, The Village of South Bloomfield acknowledges the Pickaway County 2012 Hazard Mitigation Plan recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses to life and property affected by both natural hazards that face the County and its municipal governments,

NOW, AND HEREAFTER BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL, VILLAGE OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD, PICKAWAY COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE: The Pickaway County 2012 Hazard Mitigation Plan is hereby adopted as the official Hazard Mitigation Plan of South Bloomfield , Ohio and

SECTION TWO: The respective officials and agencies identified in the implementation strategy of the Pickaway County 2012 Hazard Mitigation Plan are hereby directed to implement the recommended activities assigned to them.
